UC Center Sacramento Scholar Intern Program

PUBLIC POLICY PROGRAM

Students earn up to 12 units of academic credit during either semester or the summer while participating in three activities:

Internship (PUBP 196; 1-4 units; P/NP): Students work as part-time interns for up to 32 hours per week in Sacramento. The Sacramento Center staff will place you into an internship that matches your academic and career interests. **See reverse for examples of previous internships.**

Policy Seminar (PUBP 198; 4 units; P/NP): Students learn about the history, process, and context of California politics and policy analysis. The specific policy area studied changes each Semester. Consult the program website to see current offerings. Students also write and present a policy analysis on a topic of their choice.

Optional Elective Seminar (TBD; 4 units): Students participate in additional activities associated with the Policy Seminar, including panel discussions, presentations given by invited speakers, and writing position papers. The seminar is not available during the summer.

SUMMER PUBLIC AFFAIRS JOURNALISM PROGRAM

An experiential learning program where students learn the reporting skills and institutional context to cover California government and politics. Students polish their journalistic skills through intensive class work and an internship with a news organization as a fully credentialed reporter. Students earn up to 9 units via the UCB School of Journalism.
