Welcome to the UC Center Sacramento! We are very excited that you will be joining us for the Summer 2009 Scholar Intern Program. We hope the experience lives up to your expectations and we will do everything in our power to make that happen. Please make sure to read this entire message. It contains important information about UCCS and how we will work together over the next several weeks.

Next week, you are required to call in to a mandatory phone meeting for all Summer Program participants. In this meeting we will discuss what to expect when you arrive in Sacramento as well as the tasks and paperwork you need to complete before arriving. Because of the large number of students admitted into the summer cohort, we have actually scheduled three meetings, but **you only have to attend one of them**. Once we have received all of your materials we will begin your internship placement process – the sooner we receive your material, the better your chances of being placed in a truly world class internship.
